



## Jaydess:

Differentiation from Mirena



#### Aim of this presentation

- Until now only one intrauterine system (IUS) has been approved, Mirena
- Jaydess, a new IUS, is now also approved
- There are differences between these 2 products
- It is important that, in particular, HCPs are informed of how to differentiate between the appearances of Jaydess and Mirena



#### Duration and indication of use

- Both intrauterine systems, IUS, are T shaped devices that are placed within the uterine cavity and provide a continuous release of levonorgestrel,
- Jaydess is licensed in the indication of contraception for up to 3 years
- Mirena is licensed in the indication of contraception, heavy menstrual bleeding and endometrial protection during use of estrogen replacement therapy, for up to 5 years.


