You must be trained by your healthcare provider before you can administer Nplate®.








BEFORE YOU BEGIN

- Read all instructions for use thoroughly.
- You should establish a regular treatment schedule, even when travelling.
- Make sure you have all the supplies that you will need (refer to the images below).
- Check the expiration dates on all vials.
- Do not use if expired or left at room temperature for more than 24 hours.
- Wash your hands with soap.
- Use an alcohol swab to clean the surface where you will be preparing product.

NOTE:

Please use this mat along with the *Step-by-step guide* and/or *Package leaflet* and *Self-administration DVD* to prepare your Nplate® injection. You may be required to use more than one injection of Nplate®. If your doctor has instructed you to take more than one injection of Nplate®, follow the steps as defined in the *Step-by-step guide* to complete your prescribed dose of product using a new self-administration kit(s).

Make sure you have the following materials before you begin



Store product vials in their carton to protect from light until use. This medicine may be removed from the refrigerator for a maximum period of 24 hours at room temperature (up to 25°C). It must be returned to the refrigerator for storage longer than 24 hours. Your healthcare provider may recommend a different needle for injection.
